(*"Of Things That Matter Most,"* October 2010 General Conference)

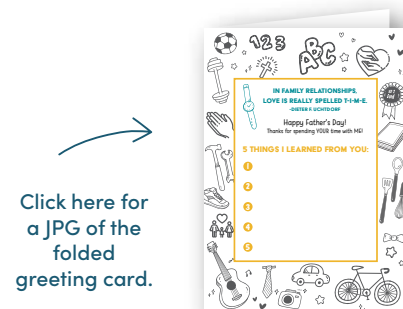
Then there is space for them to write 5 things they learned from their dad!

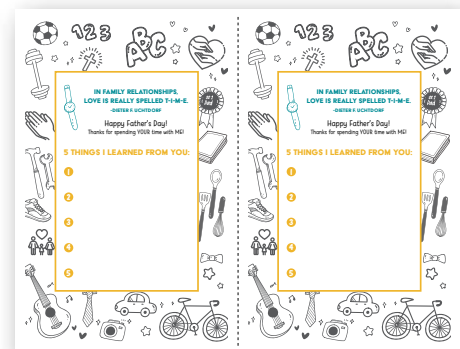
Choose a folded or flat card:

Print the 5x7" greeting card on thick paper or cardstock. Give your youth time to write a personal note to their dads or father figures in their lives.

Use the half page print option to print two flat cards to a page. Just print and cut down the middle of the page. I'd still suggest printing on cardstock, but it can be printed on regular paper, if needed. The youth can write a personalized note on the back.



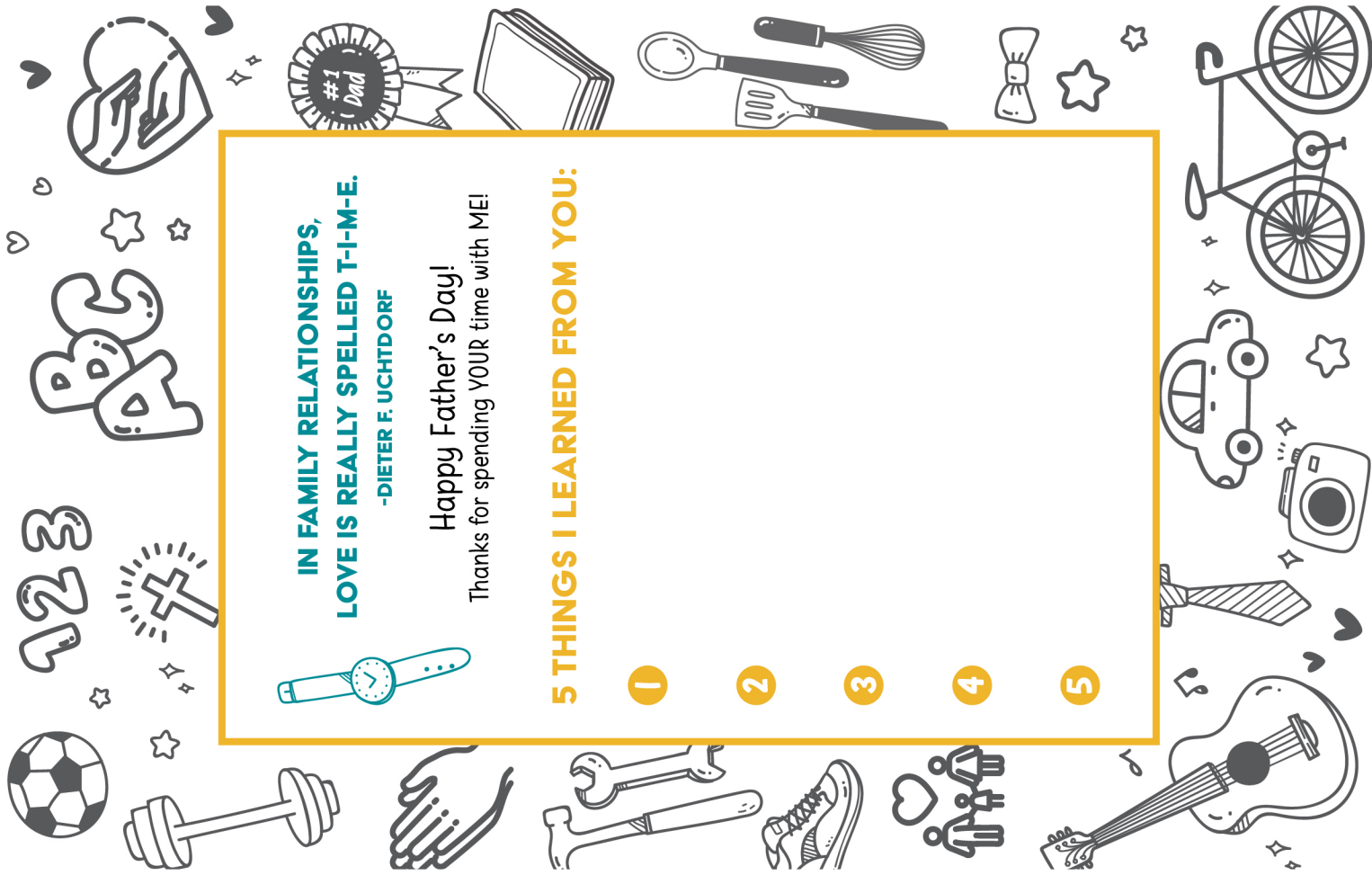

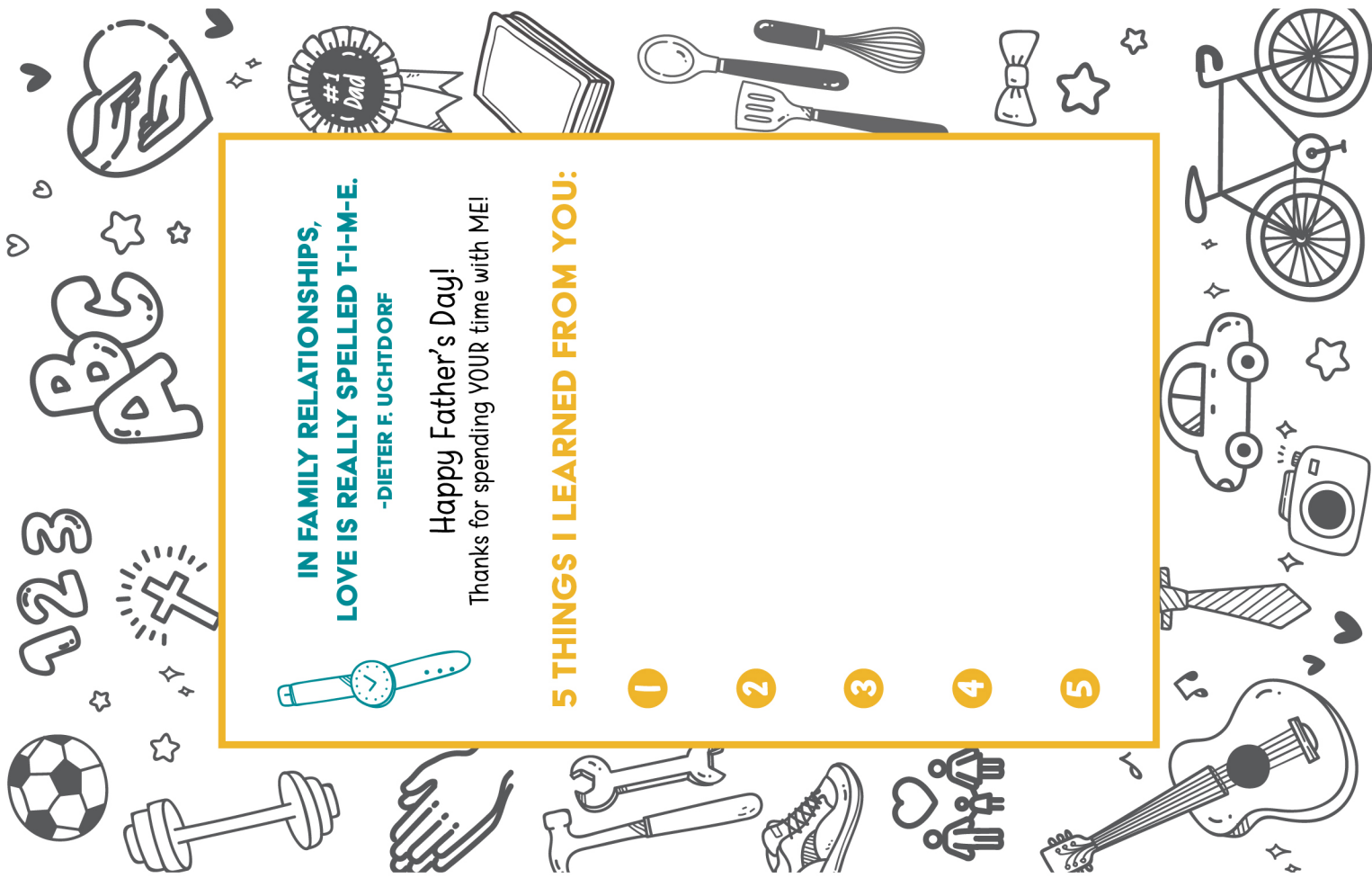
